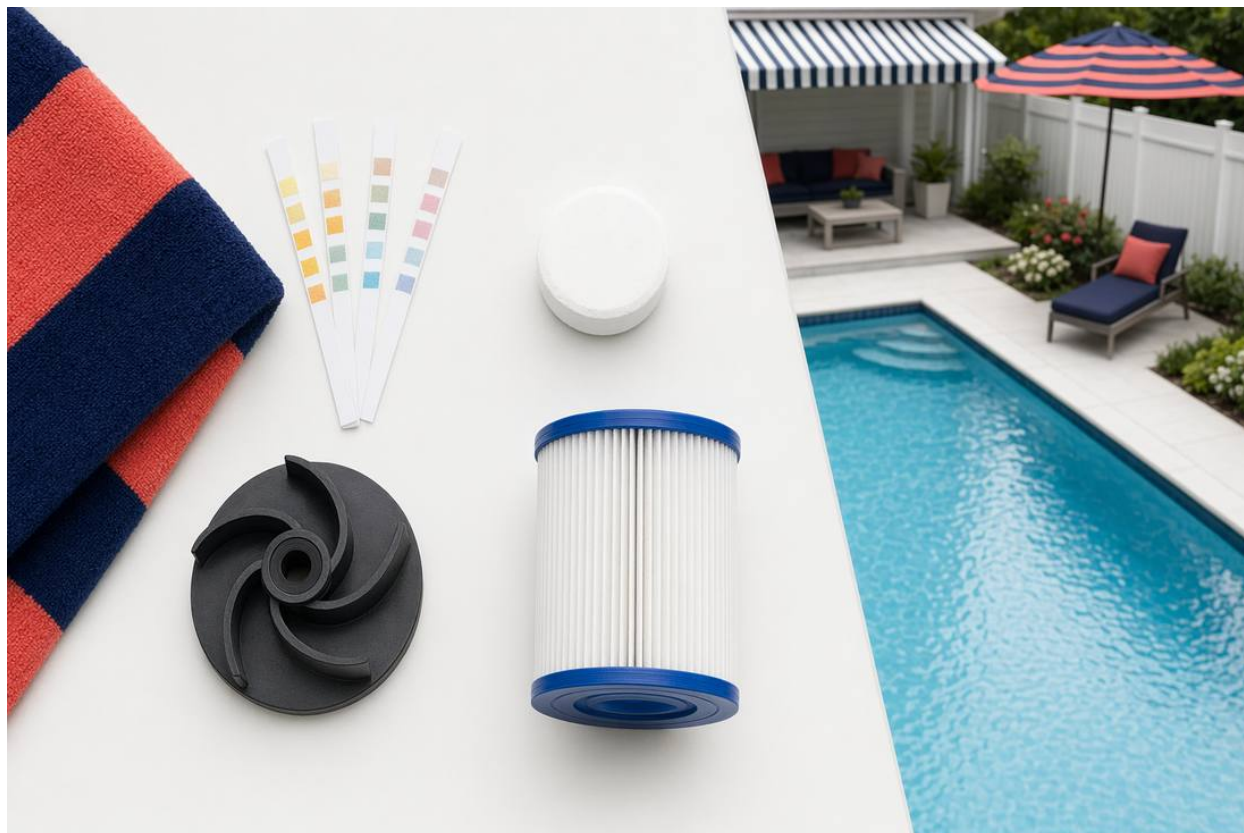

Why the cheapest quote is rarely the real bill

Two quotes for 'fixing the pool' can mean two very different jobs. The gap is usually in what's left out — parts, labor, follow-up visits, or chemicals. Compare like for like.

Line items to line up side by side

- Diagnosis or service-call fee (and whether it's credited if you hire them)
- Parts (brand, model, and whether they're new)
- Labor (hours, or a flat rate)
- Chemicals and water balancing
- Any follow-up visits to confirm the fix
- Warranty on the part and on the labor



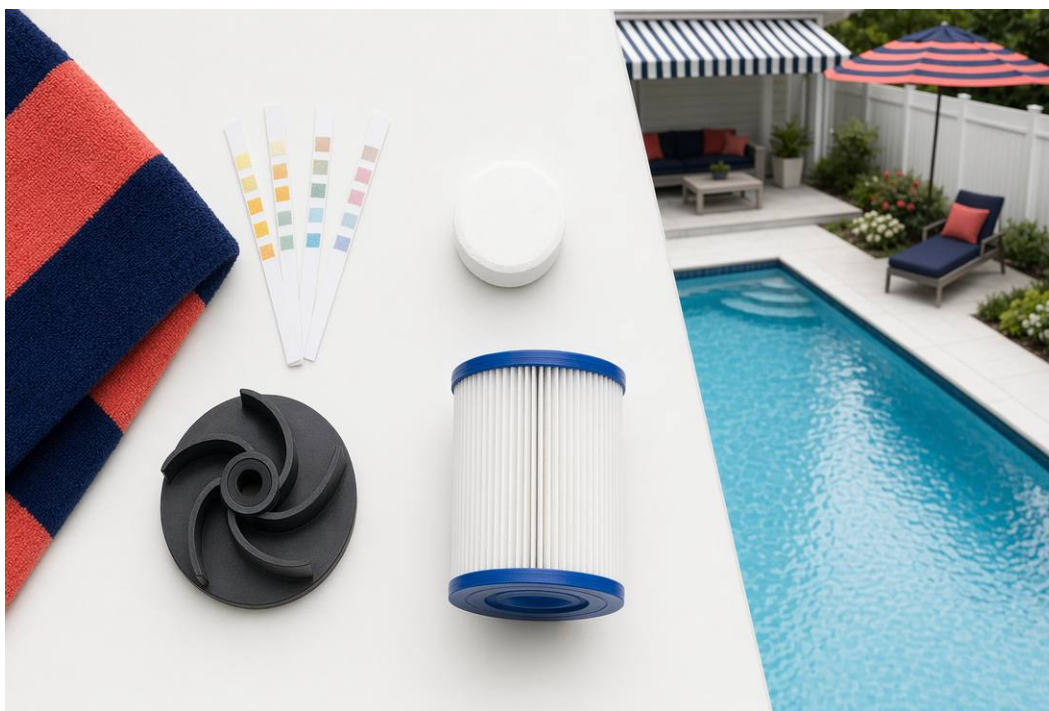
Questions that reveal the truth

- 1 What exactly is NOT included in this number?
- 2 Is this a repair, or are you recommending a full replacement — and why?
- 3 What brand and grade of part will you use?
- 4 What happens to the price if you find more once you open it up?
- 5 When is each payment due, and what's the deposit?

Score each quote

For each pro, mark whether every line above is included, excluded, or unclear. The most complete quote — not the lowest — is usually the honest one. Get the final price and scope in writing before any deposit.
